There are several types of figurative language, also called figures of speech: <b>metaphor-</b> a comparison made between two unlike objects: "The pillow was a cloud." <b>simile-</b> a comparison made between two unlike objects, using the words "like" or "as" in the comparison: "The pillow was like a marshmallow." <b>personification-</b> giving human qualities or characteristics to non-human objects: "The wind sang its sad song." <b>hyperbole-</b> truth is exaggerated for humor or emphasis: "I died when the boy I like finally talked to me."
